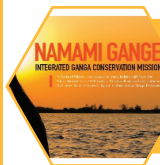

### Dear Readers,

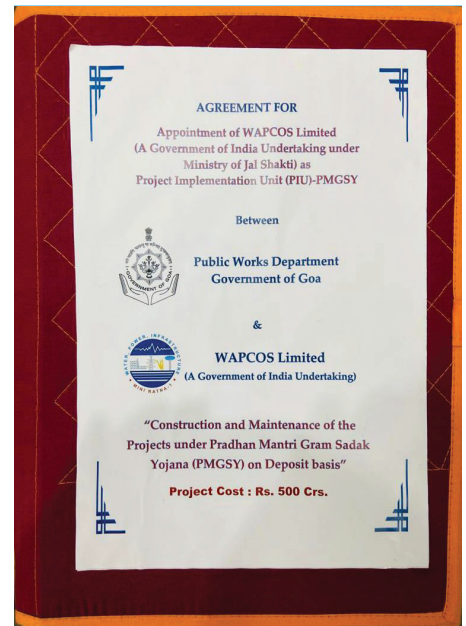

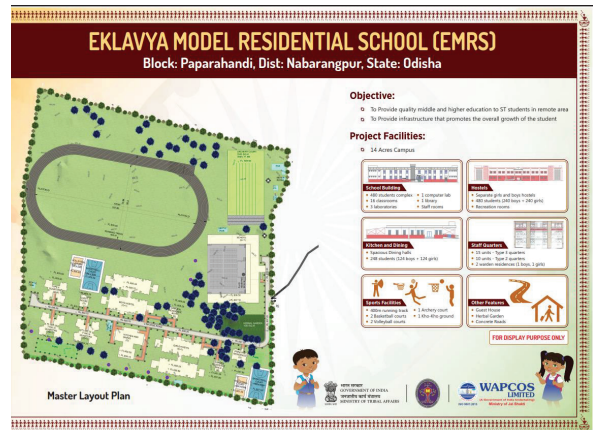
# JAN JATIYA GAURAV DIWAS & EKLAVYA MODEL RESIDENTIAL SCHOOLS

The Government of India's decision to recognize November 15<sup>th</sup>, the birth anniversary of Bhagwan Birsa Munda as Jan Jatiya Gaurav Diwas was an important milestone in Indian history, as the Hon'ble Prime Minister laid the foundation stone for 50 new Eklavya Model Residential Schools across 8 states and Union Territories.

We, at WAPCOS were honored to play a part in this historic event, as WAPCOS has been assigned the task of building one of these schools in Paparahandi, Odisha. WAPCOS representatives along with the local MLA and district residents enthusiastically welcomed

the Hon'ble PM's speech which was telecast live.

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS MR. V. MURALEEDHARAN VISITS NYABARONGO HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT IN RWANDA

**H**on'ble Union Minister of State for External Affairs & Parliamentary Affairs, Mr. V. Muraleedharan undertook an important bilateral visit to Uganda & Rwanda in Africa. During this historic visit to Rwanda on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, he co-chaired the first India-Rwanda Joint Commission Meeting along with Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Rwanda, Dr. Vincent Biruta and discussed the bilateral relations in areas of mutual interest.

WAPCOS has been an important part and played a key role in strengthening the relationships between Rwanda and India through implementation of projects under Gol Lines of Credit.

During his visit, Hon'ble Minister was briefed about the company's operations in Rwanda and its neighbouring countries.

Hon'ble Minister then visited the Nyabarongo Hydroelectric Project (Phase-I) joined by key officials of WAPCOS in Rwanda and Rwanda Energy Group. WAPCOS played a important role as Consultant for electromechanical works and power house and its technical inputs and expertise were well appreciated by the delegation.

The Hydroelectric Power project funded by Govt. of India and Rwanda, generates 28MW of power and accounts for about 20% of Rwanda's total energy requirements.





## WAPCOS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF 1500 HAND PUMPS IN RURAL CAMBODIA

**W**APCOS executed the project in 433 villages in Cambodia for drinking water supply to rural areas under Grant from the Government of India. The handing over ceremony for the project was held virtually on the 27<sup>th</sup> of September 2021, and was co-chaired by H.E. Dr. Uk Rabun, Hon'ble Minister of Rural Development (MORD), Royal Government of Cambodia & H.E. Dr. Rajkumar Ranjan Singh, Hon'ble Minister of State, External Affairs, Government of India.

The Project has given boost to the bilateral relations between India and Cambodia. WAPCOS' project team was recognized for their contributions towards providing access to safe drinking water to the rural population in tough locations of Banteay Meanchey Province, where the population until was dependent on rain water to fulfill their freshwater requirements.

National Royal medals have been awarded by the Government of Kingdom of Cambodia to Ms. Pooja Kapoor, Sr. General Manager; Mr. Rahul Israni, Sr. Engineer and Mr. Satyajit Dey, Resident Engineer under the "Royal Order of Monisaraphon in the rank of Moha Sena (Grand Officer)" conferred by Royal Decree of the King of Cambodia. These medals are conferred for distinguished services to the King and the people of Cambodia in the field of Science.

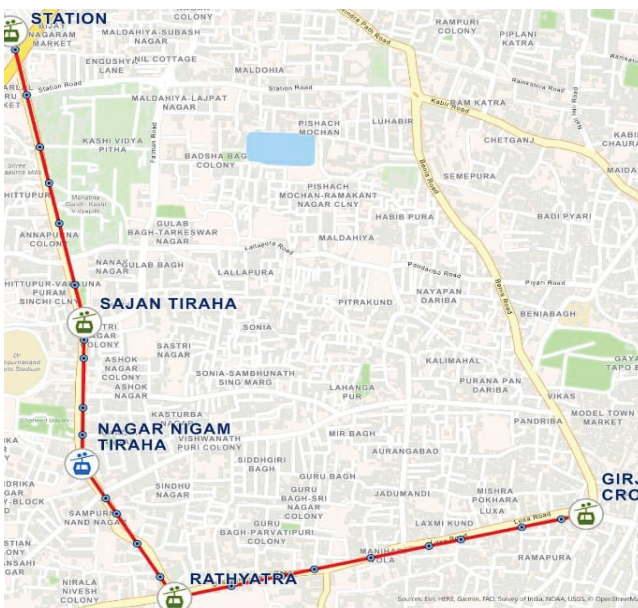
## PROJECT UPDATE: VARANASI ROPEWAYS PILOT PROJECT

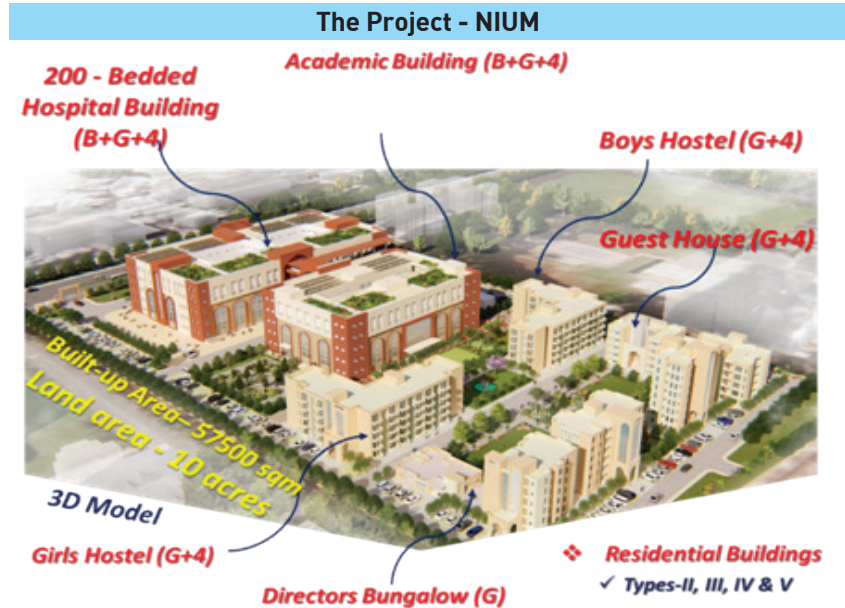
## PROJECT UPDATE: NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF UNANI MEDICINE, GHAZIABAD, UTTAR PRADESH

## PROJECT COMPLETION UPDATE: REPLACEMENT OF OVERHEAD SHIELD WIRE INSULATOR IN MOZAMBIQUE & SOUTH AFRICA

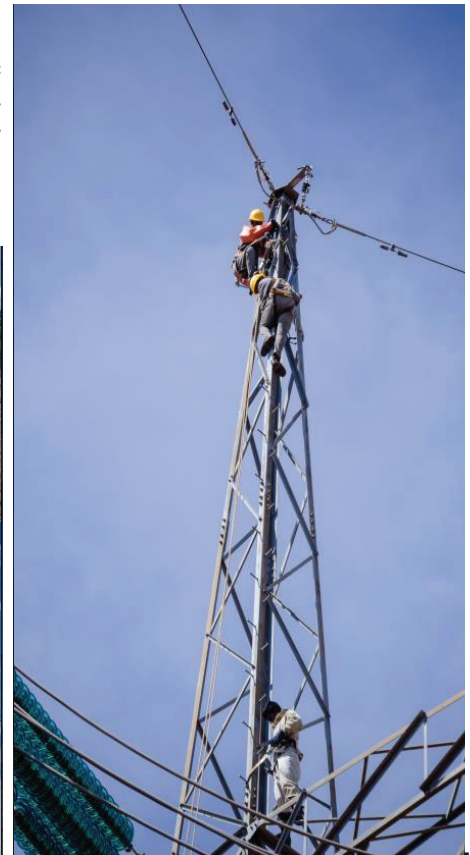
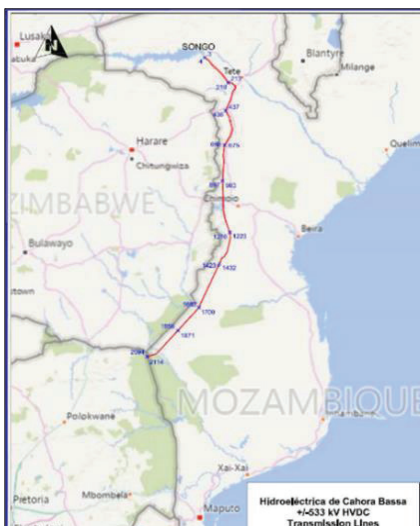
**H**idroeléctrica de CahoraBassa (HCB), a pre-eminent hydropower generation Company in Southern African Region has a hydroelectric power station at Songo (Province Tete) with an installed capacity of 2,075 MW and 1400 km of High Voltage Direct Current (HVDC) Transmission Lines between Songo Substation in Mozambique and the Apollo Substation in South Africa.

WAPCOS Limited undertook an assignment of replacement of Overhead Shield Wire Insulator on one of the +/- 533 KV energized HVDC lines between Songo Substation, Mozambique to Apollo Substation, South Africa. The project started on 13th April 2021 and completed on 03rd September 2021. The total line length of the Transmission line was 900km and a total of 2238 insulators were replaced.
