Site visit to Smart City Limited Water Front Development Project at Kopari, Thane

Shri Eknath Shinde, Hon'ble Cabinet Minister of Urban Development & Public Works, Govt. of Maharashtra and Dr. Vipin Sharma, IAS, Commissioner, Thane Municipal Corporation visited Kopri, Thane Waterfront Development project site on 5th April, 2022 and expressed their appreciation for the work carried out by WAPCOS. Mr. Rajesh Laddha, Project Manager, WAPCOS-Thane, along with officers of TMC (Thane Smart City Limited) felicitated Hon'ble Minister during his visit. Mr. Rajesh Laddha, Project Manager & Mr. Dishank Gada (Engineer-Civil) and Mr. Shrikant Gattani(Engineer-Civil), WAPCOS explained to the Hon'ble Minister the feasibility of different structures that can be constructed for the access of public to the Jetty near the creek.

Hon'ble Minister said that the project has completely changed the look of Kopri Visarjan area & he has got many reviews from the local public that they have liked the facility provided. Thane Waterfront Development project is under Thane Smart City Limited, wherein WAPCOS is in the role of PMC for proof checking of design and for the supervision of works. There are eight locations under waterfront development along the Thane creek (Asia's largest creek) each within the distance of approx. 5 km to each other. The major highlight of this project is Beautification, Landscaping, Retaining wall (Gabion), Amphitheatre, Elevated walkway, Ghat Development, etc. The soil conditions of the project are very challenging considering the fact that the ground strata is majorly consisting of marine clay as it is near to the creek.


Signing Ceremony of the Provision of Project Management Consultancy Services for Hwange Life Extension Project and Deka Extension Project, Zimbabwe

On 11th April 2022, a contract signing ceremony between Zimbabwe Power Company (ZPC) & WAPCOS Ltd. was held at Zimbabwe Power Company ZPC Head office in Harare.

Mr. Sanjay Gupta, Project Manager, WAPCOS, and Mr. Kenneth Maswera, Managing Director, ZPC exchanged the signed copies.

This project is very crucial for Zimbabwe, as Hwange Power Station (920MW) has outlived its designed life of 25 Years. The plant has already operated for more than 32 years and output is down to 400-450MW. The project will augment the generation to 880MW and life will be extended for next 15-20 years.

There are frequent outages leading to low generation, reduced efficiency leading to higher cost of energy produced and environmental problems. As such, the units urgently need the implementation of life extension program. WAPCOS will update the DPR. The major equipments to be replaced are boiler tubes, condenser tubes, valves, heaters, ID fan impellers etc. Following benefits will be achieved after the life extension:





- 1) The life of the units will increase by 15-20 years. The units will operate at optimum level. There will be a tremendous increase in the generation from the station.
- 2) The units will operate at the stable output near the design load of the units.
- 3) The efficiency of the units will increase resulting in the reduction of the cost of generation.
- 4) Project will boost local economy and will provide direct and indirect job opportunities.
- 5) It will further enhance the bilateral relations of India and Zimbabwe.



Tamil Nadu Irrigated Agriculture Modernization (IAM) Project

Ateam representing the World Bank visited sites being developed by WAPCOS under the Tamil Nadu Irrigated Agriculture Modernisation (TN IAM) Project to inspect development works from 18.04.2022 to 20.04.2022. The team inspected works that are being executed with financial assistance from the bank in Madurai region, Tiruchi and Ariyalur districts.

Under this project, 31 irrigation tanks and 29 anicuts in Tiruchi district and 19 tanks in Ariyalur district are being renovated by WAPCOS. The team also inspected some refurbished irrigation tanks such as Kandiratheertham tank in Ariyalur district and Singalanthapuram tank near Thuraiyur in Tiruchi district. The Kandiratheertham tank is said to be constructed about 1,000 years ago during the reign of King Raja Raja Chola. The Singalanthapuram tank and the Thiruthalaiyur anicut in Tiruchi district were also renovated. Here are some pictures from the team's visit:

The Tamil Nadu Irrigated Agriculture Modernization Project (TN IAM) supported by World Bank is a

follow up project of IAMWARM (Irrigated Agriculture Modernization and Water-Bodies Restoration and Management) Project. IAMWARM has made significant development impacts in the state by modernizing irrigation infrastructure, improving water use efficiency, enhancing yields and productivity of agriculture through climate resilient production systems. It has accelerated diversification towards high value crops whilst strengthening institutional reforms through Participatory Irrigation Management (PIM) and Water Users Association (WUA). The TN IAM Project will bring the policy and institutional development achieved under IAMWARM project to a new level and will serve as the key vehicle for implementing the state government's agenda of enhancing water and agriculture productivity in a sub-basin framework.

This project will also rehabilitate and high-priority tank irrigation systems in 66 sub-basins of the state, which were not part of IAMWARM.

Development of Irrigation and Watershed Management in Mahama Sector, Kirehe District (Rwanda)

WAPCOS is the Project Management Consultant for Export Targeted Modern Irrigated Agricultural Projects in Rwanda, an integrated program aimed at transforming subsistence-based agriculture in the Eastern Province of draught prone Rwanda to export-oriented agriculture in line with the strategic vision of the Government of Rwanda.

This USD 120.05 million program is funded by EXIM Bank of India under the Government of India supported Line of Credit Scheme to Rwanda.

Through this program, WAPCOS aims to provide irrigation to a Gross Command Area of 1752

Hectares and 2669 Hectares and a Cultivable Command Area of 1220 Hectares and 1956 Hectares for Lot 1 and Lot 2 respectively with the use of mechanized state of the art irrigation systems such as center pivots, sprinklers and pipe hydrants.

As Rwanda has a hilly terrain, WAPCOS strategically designed and included Dry Stone Masonry Structures, Cement Stone Masonry Structures, Crate Wire Structure, Silt Detention Structures, Bench Terraces, Contour Bunds, Agroforestry and Horticulture around the command area for an effective Watershed Management.




Discussions on WAPCOS operations in Burundi
