SECTION-II:
INSTRUCTION TO BIDDDERS

1.1 Introduction

WAPCOS invites proposal from interested agencies to submit the bid online for Selection of NABL Accredited Laboratory for analysis of Water and Soil Quality samples.

1.2 Agency

“Agency” referred here in could be Firm/ Organization/ Company/ Private Limited which could undertake the work and deems to apply for the tender as a bidder

1.3 Validity of the Offer

The Proposal shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of Proposal. If required, WAPCOS Limited in writing can request bidders for extension of the period of validity.

1.4 Right to Accept or Reject any Proposal

WAPCOS Limited reserves the right to annul the Request for Proposal process, or to accept or reject any or all the proposals in whole or part at any time without assigning any reasons and without incurring any liability to the affected Bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder(s) of the ground of such decision.

1.5 Force Majeure

For the purpose of this clause Force Majeure event means an act of God, War, Blockage, Lightening, fire, earthquake, storm, flood, epidemic, political turbulence, acts of terrorism or any other event or circumstances or combination of events & circumstances beyond the reasonable control of either parties. If the Bidder is prevented from performing its obligation due to such Force Majeure, the bidder will be remunerated for the duration of 3 months. The Affected party/ bidder shall in every instance, to the extent it is capable of doing so, use its best efforts to perform and fulfill the obligation to the extent possible with flexible solutions in such a case.

Payment to Selected Agency for period of 3 months on account of Force Majeure event, shall be paid only after the receipt of the corresponding payment from the Client.

1.6 Termination of Contract

The Selected Agency stops work for 90 days when no stoppage of work is shown on the current program and the stoppage has not been authorized by WAPCOS.

1.7 Preparation of Proposal

The Bidder must comply with the following instructions during preparation of Proposals:

- i. The Bidder is expected to carefully examine all the instructions, guidelines, terms and condition and formats of the Request for Proposal. Failure to furnish all the necessary information as required by the Request for Proposal or submission of a proposal not

substantially responsive to all the requirements of the Request for Proposal shall be at Bidder's own risk and will be liable for rejection.

- ii. The Proposal and all associated correspondence shall be written in English and shall conform to prescribed formats. Any interlineations, erasures or over writing shall be valid only if they are initialed by the authorized person signing the Proposal.
- iii. The proposal shall be in indelible ink and shall be signed by the Bidder or duly authorized person(s).
- iv. Proposals received by facsimile shall be treated as defective, invalid and rejected.
- v. Only detailed proposals complete in all respect and in the forms indicated shall be treated as valid.
- vi. No Bidder is allowed to modify, substitute or withdraw the Proposal after its submission.

1.8 Eligibility Criteria

- The Bidder must be a Reputed, Resourceful and Experienced Laboratory/ Agency in India and shall operate in conformity with the provisions of laws in India.
- Letter of Authorization/Power of Attorney issued in favour of person authorized to sign the Tender documents.
- Signed & scanned copy of duly filled Bid Acceptance Letter as per **Annexure-I**
- Laboratory should have NABL accreditation for the analysis for Physio-chemical and Biological parameters listed in the scope of work.
- Laboratory should have valid approval of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change.
- Lab should have sophisticated instruments like AAS or ICP to undertake trace metal analysis of samples of Water and Soil.
- **The Awarded Laboratory shall collect the water & soil sample from WAPCOS Gurgaon office within 24 hours of intimation by work order/telephone/email/fax etc. from the following address:**

- The parameters to be considered for quoting are given in Scope of Work. However for any other parameters other than mentioned above required to be carried out for any other specific projects, the rates shall be decided based on mutually agreed costs.
- Organizational Details to be given as per **Annexure-II**.

- Details of similar works completed in last 7 years in given format as **Annexure-III** (Documentary evidence in form of work orders and completion certificates of similar studies to be provided)

One (01) similar completed service with consultancy fees of not less than **80% of estimated cost**

Or

Two (02) similar completed services with consultancy fees of not less than **50% of estimated cost** each

Or

Three (03) similar completed services with consultancy fees of not less than **40% of estimated cost** each

Note: Similar works mean Analysis of various parameters of only Water and Soil samples

- **Letter of Incorporation/Registration Certificate:** The bidder should be an Indian Registered Company under Companies Act 1956/2013 Proprietorship Firm/ Partnership Firm / Limited company private or public or corporation.
Copy of Certificate of Incorporation/ Registration/ Partnership Deed or any other relevant document, as applicable, should be submitted along with a copy of address proof.
- **PAN Card:** Agency must have PAN (Documentary evidence is to be submitted)
- **Goods and Service Tax (GST):** Bidders are advised to get themselves registered for GST in at different place, which are mandatory, as per Govt. of India notification regarding GST. Accordingly, bidder shall submit relevant documents if already registered. If not registered till date of submission of bid, bidder will give undertaking on bidder letter head stating that they will get registered in GST as per Govt. norms before submission of bills.
- **Turnover:** Minimum Average annual turnover of the bidder shall not be less than **Rs. 2,75,000 (Rupees Two lakh seventy five thousand only)** for last three financial years, ending March 2026. Audited Balance Sheet for 5 (five) years ending financial year 2024-25 are to be enclosed. The turnover shall be certified by Chartered Accountant (CA) in the prescribed format as per **Annexure-IV. The turnover shall be certified by Statutory Auditor of the firm/company. Any such certificate must carry UDIN (Unique document Identification number).**
- **Profit after Tax:** The Bidder should not have incurred any loss (Profit after tax should be positive) in more than two years during the last Five financial years ending on the financial year 2024-25.
- **Net worth:** Bidders should submit Net worth certificate of Rs. 55,000 /- (Rupees Fifty five thousand only) issued by Chartered Accountant with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) as per **Annexure-V**
- The Bidder must not have been blacklisted by any Government agency or Public Sector Undertaking. An Undertaking on letter head to be attached as **Annexure-VI.**
- Proof of location of Registered Office or branch in National Capital Region (NCR)

- Bidder should not have been found guilty of any criminal offence by any court of law. An Undertaking on letter head to be attached.
- Bidder should not have any conflict of Interest. An Undertaking on letter head to be attached.
- **Joint Venture:** JV or Association is not allowed
- MSMEs Registration Certificate to be provided, if the bidder is registered as MSME
- The Blacklisting policy of the company is available on the official website of WAPCOS Limited. The bidder has to mandatorily furnish an undertaking addressing the same to Engineer-in-charge in the form of certificate to abide the contents of Blacklisting Policy. The format of undertaking is provided. Any action in violation of the blacklisting policy or to the certificate furnished shall result in cancellation of tender at the stage before or after the award of work. Bidder should submit the declaration as per referred Form in RFP

1.9 Earnest Money Deposit

The Bidder registered with Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) and National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) and having single point registration are exempted from payment of EMD. Such MSME's should need to produce documentary evidence showing that the firm is registered with NSIC for the work tendered for. Exemptions from submitting Earnest Money Deposit shall also available to all startups (recognized by DIPP).

The Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) of RTGS/ NEFT shall have to be uploaded by the Bidder in the e-tendering system by the time of submission of Bid.

The EMD shall be payable to WAPCOS without any condition(s), recourse or reservations

- The Bid will be rejected in case EMD is not submitted (In case EMD is not exempted).
- The EMD of unsuccessful Bidders will be returned not later than 45 (forty five) days after the expiry of Bid validity without any interest.
- The EMD of the successful Bidder will be discharged after the Bidder has furnished the required acceptable Performance Security.
- The EMD shall be forfeited:
 - If a Bidder withdraws the Bid after Bid opening during the period of validity;
 - In the case of a successful Bidder;

- i. fails to Sign the Agreement within the 15 days from the date of issue of LOA.
 - ii. fails to furnish the required Performance Security.
 - iii. fails to commence the work within the stipulated time period prescribed in the contract.
- c) If a Bidder Hides/ mis-represents facts.
- d) If a Bidder Refuses to accept Letter of Award.
- e) If a Bidder Tampers/ modifies Price Bid Template in any manner.
- f) If a Bidder Gets involved in any corrupt, collusive, coercive or fraudulent practices.

The unique transaction reference of RTGS/ NEFT shall have to be uploaded by the Tenderer in the e-tendering system by the prescribed date. WAPCOS will get the earnest money verified from financial department based on the UTR number against each RTGS/ NEFT payment before the tenders are opened.

1.10 Bidding Condition

The Bidder shall submit offers which comply fully with the requirements of the Bid Document. Any deviation in submitted Bid for the Bidding Documents shall be liable for rejection.

1.11 Format for Submittal

Format for submittal of related information for Bid shall be as per the Annexures of *Section-V (Annexures)* and shall be strictly adhered to.

1.12 Submission of Bids

Online submission of Bid

This Tender/ Bid shall follow a SINGLE STAGE TWO ENVELOPE BID SYSTEM i.e. Technical Bid and Financial Bid as given below.

a. Technical Bid

The Technical bid may be declared non responsive / invalid, if the Bid is not accompanied by the requisite documents as stipulated in clause 1.7, 1.8 and EMD as per clause 1.9 of ITB of Bid document. The Technical Bid should not contain any financial information related to Financial Bid. The technical bid shall contain:

- i. Documentary evidence of having deposited the cost of bid document and EMD quoting reference of RTGS/NEFT/FDR or Documentary Proof in the form of valid certification from NSIC for the tendered item/services.
- ii. Signed & scanned copy of all duly filled Forms and Annexures as per Tender documents.
- iii. All the necessary documents required for evaluation of the bid.

1.13 Cost of Bidding

The Bidder shall bear all the costs associated with the preparation and submission of Bid and WAPCOS in no case will be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding process.

1.14 Estimated Cost of Project

Estimated Cost of Project is Rs. 5,50,000 /- (Rupees Five Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) including GST.

1.15 Pre-bid Clarification

A prospective Bidder, requiring a clarification on the Request for Proposal shall notify WAPCOS Limited at the address environment@wapcos.co.in specified in the Data Sheet before 2 days of tender submission date as mentioned in (<https://gem.gov.in>).

1.16 Amendment of Bid Documents

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, WAPCOS may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the Bidding Documents by the issuance of a Corrigendum/Addendum. No modification of Bid shall be permissible after last date of submission, whatever may be the reason. WAPCOS may at its discretion extend as necessary the deadline for submission of Tender/ Bid, if considered necessary.

1.17 Language of Bid

The Bid prepared by the Bidder and all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged between the Bidder and WAPCOS shall be written in the **English language** only.

1.18 Submission of Proposal

Technical Proposal –The Technical Proposal shall comprise of the following:

- a) Signed & scanned copy of duly filled Bid Acceptance Letter as per **Annexure-I**
- b) Organizational Details as per **Annexure-II**
- c) Signed & scanned copy of Certificate of Incorporation issued by Registrar of Companies along with Memorandum & Articles of Association and full address of the registered office.
- d) Signed & scanned copies of documents for GST Certificate, PAN, & EPF
- e) Details of Similar Works Completed as per **Annexure-III** along with certificates and work orders.
- f) Financial Statement as per **Annexure-IV**
- g) Signed & scanned copy of Audited Balance Sheets for the last five years as a proof of turnover and profit details
- h) Net worth certificate issued by Chartered Accountant with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) as per **Annexure-V**
- i) Proof of location of Registered Office or branch in National Capital Region (NCR)
- j) Undertaking for non-blacklisting as per **Annexure-VI**

1.19 Performance Guarantee

- The Successful Bidder shall within Ten (10) days of the acceptance of the LOI, execute a Performance Guarantee as per contract in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from a Nationalized/Scheduled Bank, for an amount equivalent to the 2% of the accepted Contract Value, which shall be kept valid for the entire period of work, i.e. till the issue of completion Certificate. The Performance Guarantee of the successful Bidder will be invoked and forfeited if he fails to comply with any of the conditions of contract.
- The Contractor shall from time to time at the request of the WAPCOS Limited suitably extend the validity of Performance Guarantee as may from time to time be required by WAPCOS Limited, failing which, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to WAPCOS Limited, WAPCOS Limited shall be entitled to encash the Bank Guarantee.

1.20 Clarification of Bids

To assist in the examination, comparison and evaluation of Bid, WAPCOS may ask Bidders for clarification of the Bids, if any. But no change in price or substances of Bid will be sought, agreed or permitted. The request for clarification and its response shall invariably be in writing.

1.21 Determination of Responsiveness

Prior to detailed evaluation of Bid it will be determined whether each Bid:

- i) has been properly signed.
- ii) is accompanied by required securities.
- iii) is substantially responsive to the requirement of Bidding document.
- iv) provides necessary clarification or substance.

A Substantially Responsive Bid is one which conforms to all the terms, conditions & specifications without material deviation or reservation which

- i) affects in any substantial way the quality or scope of the work.
- ii) limits in any substantial way the scope of work
- iii) is inconsistent with the Bidding document
- iv) affects unfairly the competitive position of other Bidder.

Bids not found Substantially Responsive are liable to be rejected. Conditions if added by the Bidder, which have adverse bearing on the cost and scope of tendered work shall make the Tender/ Bid liable to disqualification.

1.22 Corrections of Errors in Bids

Bids will be checked for any arithmetical error and will be corrected by WAPCOS irrespective of concurrence of the Bidder. If the Bidder does not accept the corrected amount of Bid, his Bid will be rejected and the Bid Security will be forfeited.

1.23 Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

WAPCOS will only evaluate and compare the Bids determined to be Substantially Responsive. In evaluating Bids, WAPCOS will determine, for each Bid, the Evaluated Bid Price by adjusting the Bids Price as follows:

- i. making any correction for errors.
- ii. making an appropriate adjustment for any discount and

WAPCOS reserves the right to accept or reject any variation, deviation or alternative offers. Variations, deviations, alternative offers and other factors which are in excess of the requirements of the Bidding Documents or otherwise result in the accrual of unsolicited benefits to WAPCOS shall not be taken into account in Bid evaluation.

1.24 Liquidity Damages

If the bidder fails to complete the various job assigned to him as per the scope of the work in the given time mentioned under progress Schedule he is liable for compensation. He shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy be liable for compensation @ 0.5% per week, subject to a maximum of 10%. The amount of compensation may be adjusted or set off against any sum payable to the bidder under this or any other contract with the Client.

1.25 Dispute Resolution

1.25.1 Governing Law, Jurisdiction & Waiver of Alternative Remedies

1.25.1.1 Governing Law: This Contract shall be governed and interpreted strictly in accordance with the laws of India. No foreign law, conflict-of-laws principle, or external rule shall apply, unless expressly mandated by a funding agency and separately approved in writing by the Competent Authority.

1.25.1.2 Exclusive Jurisdiction: Subject to prior exhaustion of the internal dispute-resolution tiers stipulated in this Contract, the Parties agree that all suits, actions, or proceedings arising out of or in connection with this Contract, including its formation, validity, performance, breach, or termination, shall be instituted exclusively before the competent civil courts at Delhi, being the place where the Company's Registered Office is situated, to the exclusion of all other courts. The Parties irrevocably waive any objection relating to forum non conveniens, place of suing, or inconvenience.

1.25.1.3 Exclusion of arbitration & consensual ADR: The Parties unequivocally agree that no dispute shall be referred to arbitration, conciliation, expert determination, Dispute Review Board, or any other form of consensual alternative dispute resolution, except where statutorily mandated (eg., MSMED Act). This exclusion is without prejudice to the mandatory pre-litigation mediation process stipulated in Clause 25.2.3 below.

1.25.1.4 The parties expressly agree that there is no arbitration agreement between them and they irrevocably waive any right to invoke arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or to constitute an arbitral tribunal in any manner whatsoever.

1.25.2 STRUCTURED INTERNAL DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISM (SIDRM)

1.25.2.1 Tier-I: Dispute resolution by Engineer-in-Charge (EIC)

1.25.2.1.1 Notice of Dispute: Any Dispute must be notified in writing to the EIC within 21 days from the date on which the aggrieved Party became, or ought reasonably to have become, aware of the event giving rise to the Dispute.

1.25.2.1.2 Contents of Notice: The notice shall contain (i) complete facts and chronology; (ii) precise contractual clauses invoked; (iii) a quantified claim with calculations; and (iv) full supporting records such as drawings, DPRs, MBs, photographs, test results, correspondence, and site registers, vague, omnibus, or un-particularised notices shall be summarily rejected without prejudice to WAPCOS.

1.25.2.1.3 EIC's Decision: The EIC shall examine the matter, including through joint site verification of expert inputs as needed, and shall issue a speaking order within 30 days of receiving a complete notice.

1.25.2.1.4 Binding Effect: The EIC's decision shall bind both Parties unless a written request seeking escalation to Tier-II is filed within 15 days from the date of issuance of EIC's decision. Absence of a timely request shall render the EIC decision final.

1.25.2.2 Tier-II: Departmental Review Committee (DRC)

1.25.2.2.1 Constitution: A standing Departmental Review Committee, consisting of three senior officers including two Technical and one Finance/ Account officer, shall independently review disputes escalated from Tier-I.

1.25.2.2.2 Review Process: The DRC shall conduct a record-based administrative review of the Tier-I file, supplemented by written submissions from the Contractor. The committee may permit oral hearings if it deems them necessary for a fair decision.

1.25.2.2.3 Decision & Finality: The DRC shall deliver reasoned determination within 30 days of referral, extendable once by 30 days for, if resolution takes time, with reasons recorded. This determination shall constitute the final administrative decision of WAPCOS.

1.25.2.3 MANDATORY PRE-LITIGATION MEDIATION

1.25.2.3.1 Obligation to Mediate: Following the DRC decision (or deemed decision), either Party may initiate pre-litigation mediation. Where the dispute qualifies as a 'commercial dispute' under the Commercial Courts Act, 2015, this mediation shall satisfy the mandatory pre-litigation requirement under Section 12A of the said Act.

1.25.2.3.2 Mediation Parameters: Mediation shall be conducted by a mediator empanelled with the High Court or a Government-notified mediation service provider in accordance with the Mediation Act, 2023. The timelines and extension provisions stipulated in the Act shall apply.

1.25.2.3.3 Approval of Settlement: Any mediated settlement agreement shall be subject to final written approval and execution by the Competent Authority of WAPCOS. The mediator shall be informed at the outset that the authorized representative of WAPCOS does not have the inherent power to bind WAPCOS to a settlement without such approval. If such approval is not granted within 30 days of the settlement terms being presented, the settlement shall be deemed not concluded, and the mediation shall be treated as unsuccessful.

1.25.3 CIVIL COURT JURISDICTION & CONSEQUENCES OF BREACH

1.25.3.1 Exhaustion of Remedies: A Party may file a civil suit only after (a) obtaining a DRC decision or deemed decision, and (b) participating in the mandatory mediation process and obtaining a failure report.

1.25.3.2 Mandatory Pleadings: Every plaint shall specifically demonstrate compliance with Tier-I, Tier-II, and Tier-III requirements. Failure to do so shall render the plaint liable to rejection.

1.25.3.3 Any attempt to initiate arbitration or file a civil suit without first exhausting the mandatory tiers stipulated above shall constitute a material breach of contract. WAPCOS shall be entitled to seek appropriate relief from the court, including but not limited to an injunction to restrain such proceedings, and to recover all associated costs and expenses.

1.25.4 GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.25.4.1 Severability: If any portion of this Clause is invalidated by a court, the remaining parts shall remain in force.

1.25.4.2 Amendment: This Clause may be amended only by a written instrument signed by the CMD or an expressly authorized officer of WAPCOS.

1.25.4.3 Failure to continue performance shall constitute a material breach entitling WAPCOS to terminate the Contract without prejudice to its other right.

1.26 Preference to Make In India

- The provisions of revised 'Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order 2017-Revision' issued by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion under Ministry of Commerce and Industry vide letter no.-P45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) as amended on 16.09.2020 shall be applicable to the bidding process and award of the contract shall be done accordingly.
